

Welcome to the 2021 Washington County Fair:

The Washington County Fair welcomes all of you back this year to share in our fair experience as exhibitors and fair goers. The 2021 Fair season brings with it many new facets that encourage our surrounding agricultural communities to participate in the fair experience that is right here in our backyard.

We are celebrating our 61st year at the 392 Old Schuylerville Road location and will be providing classes in several departments that are to highlight Washington County. These classes will be identified as "Pride of Washington County". There is a Quick Reference Guide that can be found on the inside cover of the back page, but the details of the classes can be found in their corresponding departments. Please be sure to read through the rules and regulations of the departments and enter your creations to show off your Pride of Washington County. We hope that you enjoy exhibiting your creations that abound in our beautiful Washington County.

Please read this Exhibitor Handbook carefully and follow the directions in completing your entry forms. We strongly recommend that you to make a copy of your entry forms before submitting them to the Entry Office. Remember to include all other forms required for your entries such as your Stall Request and a copy of registration papers (for registered livestock). For all static exhibits (those that are non-animal) please make sure that your entry is complete and has all the information required. RABIES & ANIMAL IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

For 2021 Fair, all cattle, horses, goats, sheep, & swine that are 4 months of age or older must be vaccinated for rabies at least 14 days prior to arrival on the fairgrounds and not more than 365 day prior.

Cattle & Swine must be identified by an official USDA approved eartag. Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) eartags, commonly referred to as "840 RFID tags" are strongly recommended, but not required for 2021 Fair. (As per NYS Ag. & Markets)

Please read the NY State Ag. & Markets Part 350 & Part 351 for Standards & Health Requirements for Admission to NY State & County Fairs (Pg. 19-28) Contact your Veterinarian with questions or concerns regarding animals.

IMPORTANT DATES:

Ownership & Transfer of Ownership for YOUTH Livestock Exhibitors is JUNE 15th.

Ownership & Transfer of Ownership for OPEN CLASS Livestock Exhibitors is JULY 15th.

If a transfer has taken place and you have not received the actual registration paper, an email letter of confirmation from the appropriate Breed Association will be accepted. However, a copy of the actual registration paper will still be required by August 2nd.

Leased Animal paperwork is due to 4-H Office by June 15 @4:30pm

Entries must be POSTMARKED by Wednesday, July 28th,

Entries must be DELIVERED to the Entry Office by 6:00pm Friday, July 30th,

Entries must be SUBMITTED Online by midnight Monday, August 2nd.

Last day that copies of Registration Papers will be accepted is August 2nd.

Camper Application Form is due to the Fair Office by July 28th by 6pm.

EXHIBITOR PASSES

Exhibitor Passes will be based on the number of entries checked—in. Passes will be distributed on Saturday, Sunday and Monday prior to Fair when Exhibitors pick up their Entry Lists & Tags in the Entry Office or at the designated locations (H & H building or Toy Farm Building) Open Exhibitors that have paid their entry fees and have checked –in their animals and items, may purchase discounted day passes until Tuesday evening @ 8pm of Fair. The passes are available in packs of seven (7) for \$18.00. There is a maximum of 4 packs of seven (7) that may be purchased. If you have questions please contact the Entry Office during business hours.
