<p>Entry Dead Lines</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Last Day for Entries to be Postmarked is WEDNESDAY JULY 28th</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Last day for Entries to be Hand Delivered to the Entry Office is FRIDAY JULY 30th by 6:00pm.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Last day for entries to be SUBMITTED OnLine is Monday August 2nd by midnight Make sure you get 2 confirmations : (1) confirming you are registered as an exhibitor and (2) an email that confirms your entries have been submitted (approved / rejected) (You must also submit payment required at time of submission.)</p>
<p>Exhibitor Eligibility</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Must be a resident of Washington County to enter except for the Open Horse Show and Truck & Tractor Pulls, and Demolition Derby. Youth must be a resident of Washington County, attend a school in Washington County or be a member of a 4-H Club, FFA or Scouts in Washington County. Exceptions for Live-stock: If the primary farm is located & operated in Washington County but the owner is a non-resident, they will be allowed to exhibit their animals at the fair. 2) Minimum age for Exhibitor is 5yrs old by December 1st of current year. 3) Youth are 5yrs.old as of Dec. 1st of current yr. & under 19yrs of age as of January 1st of current year.

Check –In will take place in the Picnic Pavilion (the old show ring) this year due to COVID-19 protocols to prevent congestion in the Youth Building for Face to Face Judging. Entry Tags for Youth Building Items will be available for pickup in the PICNIC PAVILION. ◆ DOMESTIC ARTS OPEN CLASSES including TEXTILES, FINE ARTS, PHOTOGRAPHY, CRAFTS, FURNIISHINGS & WOODWORKING, and CULINARYARTS will be CHECKED-IN AT THE PICNIC PAVILION on SATURDAY before fair between 9am & 3pm. Entry Tags for these Items will be available for pickup there. ◆ OPEN FLOWERS, OPEN FARM PRODUCE, and CHRISTMAS TREES & GREENS are to be brought in to the Handmade & Homegrown Building MONDAY, opening day of Fair. Entry Tags for these Items will be available for pickup there. OPEN FARM PRODUCE to be brought in between 9:00am—12:00pm OPEN FLOWERS to be brought in between 9:00am—2:00pm OPEN CHRISTMAS TREES & GREENS to be brought in between 9:00am—10:00am. <p>Open & Youth Wool & Fiber are to be brought in by MONDAY of Fair before 11am to Barn #32. Judging will begin at 12noon. Youth Exhibitors are required to be present for face to face judging.</p> <p>Animal Exhibits are to be in place by MONDAY opening day, Before 5pm. Check with Superintendents about timing of bringing animals in.</p>
<p>Fair Hours</p>	<p>The Fair officially opens @5:00pm, Monday, August 23rd. The gates will be manned all day Monday & Admission charged to those not directly involved in set up of exhibits & concessions.</p> <p>Monday—Sunday Fair Hours are 9:00am—12:00 midnight.</p>
<p>DISMISSAL of Exhibits is 9:30 pm SUNDAY for all exhibitors</p>	<p>*Displays must remain intact until 9:30pm on Sunday. This includes signs, ribbons, etc. <u>Sunday Evening Exhibit Removal Schedule:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *9:00pm-Buildings will close & vendors can begin break-down. *9:30pm-Exhibitors can begin to collect exhibits. Animals can be <u>walked</u> off to trailers in staging area-horse trailer parking. *10:00pm-Gates will open for vehicle traffic. *9:30pm—11:00pm-Buildings open for exhibit removal. Building Superintendents will post how late each building will be open.
