Judging will be done at the time the diorama is being setup.</li> <li>Max dimensions: 2' x 3'6". Must be mounted or displayed on a firm base. No higher than 15".</li> <li>Each youth should be able to explain the Diorama's theme at judging.</li> <li>Must include a brief description of your project that can be read by fairgoers.</li> <li>Limit one (1) entry per class.</li> </ul>
