<b>Entry Fee</b>	<b>OPEN: \$2.00 per class</b> <b>YOUTH: NO Entry Fee</b>
<b>Arrival of Exhibits</b>	<b>OPEN:</b> <b>YOUTH: Saturday before Fair 9am—3pm: Ag. Related Dioramas</b>
<b>Limitations</b>	<b>Each exhibitor may enter only 1 entry per class.</b>
<b>Rules &amp; Regulations</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All <b>OPEN</b> entries must be in place by <b>9:45am on Monday.</b></li> <li>2. All entries must be by one individual (<b>exception: group class of Ag. Related Diorama</b>)</li> <li>3. Fair will provide shelving w/protective covering. Shelves are 12" Deep by 12" High. Max length of entry of 8'.</li> <li>4. Classes to be judged for authenticity, quality, theme, originality, and condition. Toys only to be judged. Literature and other non-toy pieces will not be judged as a part of the display but are encouraged to enhance the displays for the fair patrons.</li> </ol>
<b>Definitions</b>	<b>Customized:</b> mass produced toys altered/modified/changed to be different from stock product <b>Stock Item:</b> mass produced toys unaltered from original production.
<b>VOLUNTEERS Needed in TOY BUILDING</b>	For security reasons it would be greatly appreciated if each adult exhibitor would volunteer to staff the Toy Building for at least 1 shift during the Fair. Time may be scheduled prior to Fair by contacting the show superintendent. A scheduling sheet will also be available for sign up during fair week. A DAY PASS will be issued to each person who volunteers to man the Toy Building for each day they are scheduled. <b>We greatly appreciate all the time you can donate to us and our building of exhibits.</b>
<b>YOUTH Agricultural Related DIORAMA INFORMATION &amp; Rules</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Refer to <b>YOUTH AGRICULTURAL ENGINEERING DEPT, SECTION: AGRICULTURAL RELATED DIORAMA</b></li> <li>• Judging is Saturday, <b>BEFORE FAIR 9am—3pm in the TOY/TRACTOR BUILDING.</b></li> <li>• Youth must be present for Judging. Judging will be done at the time the diorama is being setup.</li> <li>• Max dimensions: <b>2' x 3'6"</b>. Must be mounted or displayed on a firm base. No higher than 15".</li> <li>• Each youth should be able to explain the Diorama's theme at judging.</li> <li>• Must include a brief description of your project that can be read by fairgoers.</li> <li>• Limit one (1) entry per class.</li> </ul>
<b>Pedal Tractor Pull Rules</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Start Time will be 11am Saturday of Fair.</b> Location to be announced.</li> <li>2. Sign up will be in the TOY BUILDING. Sign up sheets available the Saturday prior to Fair throughout Fair week until the Pedal Pull at 10am.</li> <li>3. All registrants <b>MUST BE WASHINGTON COUNTY RESIDENTS.</b> A parent must sign the participant up.</li> <li>4. Age Groups are 4 yr. olds—8 yr. olds.</li> <li>5. Fair will provide the tractors for pulling.</li> <li>6. Trophies will be awarded for 3 places in each class.</li> <li>7. Participants must at least sit on the tractor &amp; attempt to pull to be eligible for awards.</li> </ol>

**SECTION: OPEN**

**CLASSES:**

- 1/16 Best Display of One Brand**—10 pieces max. (May be stock, custom or both.)
- 1/16 Custom**—modified or scratch built by owner, 5 pieces max
- 1/16 Customized**—10 pieces max
- 1/16 Stock**—10 pieces max
- 1/32**—10 pieces max
- 1/64 Customized by Exhibitor**—15 pieces max
- 1/64 Customized Purchased**—15 pieces max
- 1/64 Stock**—30 pieces max
- **Agricultural Related Antique**—items need to be a minimum of 25 yrs. old— 4' shelf
- Agricultural Related Diorama**—Miniature display (2' x 3'6"). Must be mounted on a firm base.  
Please include a brief description of your project that can be read by Fair goers. Exhibitor does  
Not need to be present for judging.
- Agricultural Toys**—All sizes, all brands, 8' shelf, no height restrictions
- Non—Agricultural Related Antique Toy**—items must be a minimum of 25 yrs. old—4' shelf
- Display of NASCAR Die Cast or Memorabilia**—max 8'
- Other Ag. Related LARGE Display**—8' (examples: related memorabilia, construction toys, trucks, etc.)
- Other Ag. Related SMALL Display**—4' (examples: related memorabilia, construction toys, trucks, etc.)
- Other—Not Limited to Ag. Related Items**—can include collectables, memorabilia (hats, pins, sports, Hess trucks, firetrucks, etc.) 4' shelf, no limitations on number of pieces.
- Restored Pedal Tractor**
- Stock Pedal Tractor**—un-restored, original condition—Limit of 1.

- 1/32 Stock**—(Exhibitor 10yrs of age & Under) 10 pieces max.
- 1/32 Stock**—(Exhibitors 11—16yrs. of age) - 10 pieces max.
- 1/64 Stock**—(Exhibitors 5 yrs. of age) - 15 pieces max
- 1/64 Stock**—(Exhibitors 6—10yrs. of age) - 15 pieces max.
- 1/64 Stock**—(Exhibitors 11—16yrs. of age) - 15 pieces max.
- Display of NASCAR Die Cast of Memorabilia**—4' max.
