### **ANIMAL EXHIBITORS:**

#### **CATTLE & SWINE**

All cattle and swine are now REQUIRED to have an **840 RFID EARTAG** (those that already have an existing 840 Visual tag are exempt). Please read Animal Identification requirements carefully.

#### **SWINE**

Swine Dept. now has both an Open & Youth Department. Open entries are limited to space available.

The Open Swine show will also have Showmanship classes (that are optional for adults).

#### **DRAFT SHOW**

There is no longer a separate Youth Show.

The Youth classes are within the OPEN Shows and will be judged using the Danish System.

The Draft Horse Shows will now include Fitting & Showmanship Classes as well as Conformation Classes.
